

Superheroes

Week starting 5th June 2023

Take a look at some of the exciting things we are going to be doing and learning!

Personal, Social, Emotional <u>Development</u>

We will develop a sense of responsibility. Using the role play area to set up a headquarters for superheroes, so the children can report problems and think of ways to fix them within playgroup.

We will have costumes for dressing up and think of ways we can take turns and share them.

We will discuss how superheroes help each other and work as a team. We will decide some super rules to follow in the setting.

Physical Development

We will be talking and exploring foods that superheroes need to eat to stay healthy. Children to use child-safe knifes to help with the preparation of snack time.

We will be developing our fine motor skills by using our super powers to help save people and objects from traps. (Masking tape, string, sticky tape, tweezers, scissors) we will also be using playdough to make figures and faces of our favourite superhero.

We will by playing 'superhero follow my leader' moving in different ways up, over, under and around apparatus. Children to take turns in being the leader.

Communication and Language

We will be talking about our superpowers as sharing them with the group allowing everybody to discuss if they agree or disagree with the superpower.

We will explore vocabulary associated with superheroes and seeing if we can think of our own words to add to the list.

We will be playing 'superhero says game, following two parts or three-part instruction.

Mathematics

We will be using our superpowers to find and order things by weight, height and length.

We will be recognising sets of two or three superheroes without counting (subitising) We will also match group of two or three items to groups of superheroes and counting them all to find the total.

We will be using our superpower in our fingers by mark-making /writing tallies, mark and numbers in gloop and on paper etc.

We shall also be.....

- Increasing our vocabulary by learning new songs and listening to new stories.
- Planting and growing and looking after some fruit and vegetables to keep everyone healthy.
- Creating stories and games using superhero figures and construction toys.
