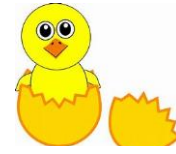

What are we doing this term?

Sun Hats and Sun Cream!!!!!!

PLEASE SEND IN SUNHATS AND SUNCREAM EVERYDAY. IT CAN GET VERY HOT!



Please, apply suncream on your child before they join us for their session/s. Also send in a named, bottle of sun cream we will apply the cream once again or, as needed. As you can imagine there are lots of children in the group so it will really help us if the suncream is applied at home prior to coming in. If you prefer, for a donation of £2, we will provide factor 50 sun cream for your child for use in playgroup to the end of the summer term. Simply let Claire know, bring in the £2 and Claire will ask you to sign a permission slip. Please make sure the hat and sun cream are clearly labelled with your child's name.



How to be Sun Safe with Shade Man



Sunscreen must be applied before you go outside in the sun for it to work



Wear sunglasses and don't look directly at the sun



To keep protected you should use all forms of cover including hats, sunglasses, clothing, sunscreen and shade



Wear a hat such as a sun cap like mine to keep your head cool and protected



Don't stay in the sun any longer than 15 minutes without protection



Keep hydrated, especially on very warm days



Always play in the shade



Reapply sunscreen regularly even when using 'once a day' and 'water resistant' sunscreens
